



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

**THE UNIVERSITY OF ADELAIDE,
AUSTRALIA**

and

**DIPONEGORO UNIVERSITY,
INDONESIA**

1. The University of Adelaide and Diponegoro University wish to collaborate in order to benefit their research and teaching activities, and to further the internationalisation of both universities.
2. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish a framework within which co-operation may develop between the two institutions. This will occur within the context of the regulations and policies of each university, and subject to the availability of resources.
3. Co-operation between the two universities may include such activities as:
 - Participation in PhD and research masters programs at the University of Adelaide by staff of Diponegoro University and by staff of government agencies facilitated by Diponegoro University
 - Short-term professional development programs at the University of Adelaide for staff of Diponegoro University and for staff of government agencies facilitated by Diponegoro University
 - Collaboration in research
 - Collaborative degree programs at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels
 - Exchange student and teaching experiences
 - Joint quality assurance and benchmarking
 - Such other projects for mutual benefit that are agreed upon by both parties
4. Specific programs or activities will be undertaken under this MOU only after the written separate agreement of both universities. The terms and conditions of the program or activity, including any financial arrangements, shall be set out in a separate written Agreement signed by an authorised representative of each university.


5. Both parties shall designate a liaison officer for this MOU and for any subordinate agreements under this MOU. For the University of Adelaide, the office shall be the Pro Vice-Chancellor (International). For Diponegoro University, the liaison office shall be Vice Rector for Development and Collaboration.
6. This MOU comes into effect when the last signatory signs. It will remain in effect for a period of 5 years from that date. Not less than six months prior to its expiry, the two universities will review its operation and decide whether or not to renew it. Any such renewal shall be signed by an authorised representative of each university, and may include variations to this Memorandum.
7. This MOU may be terminated by the written mutual consent of both universities, or by either university giving 60 days written notice to the other university.
8. This MOU places no financial or legal obligations on either of the universities, nor does it create any legal relationship between them.
