**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
DIPONEGORO UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA
AND
RADBOD UNIVERSITY NIJMEGEN, THE NETHERLANDS**

Diponegoro University, hereinafter referred to as the (1), and Radboud University Nijmegen hereinafter referred to as the (2);

Considering their common interest in promoting mutual co-operation in the educational, research and community service, subject areas of medical science, public health, and possibly environmental sciences, law, social sciences, and information and communication technology (ICT).

Have agreed as follows:

**ARTICLE I
OBJECTIVES**

The objective of this cooperation will be focused on the medical science, public health, and possibly environmental sciences, law, social sciences, ICT.

**ARTICLE II
SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES**

The scope of activities of the co-operation shall include but not be limited to:

1. Exchange of teaching experiences
2. Development of courses/workshops/seminars
3. Staff development/joint research/research
4. Community service/extension training
5. Exchange scientific information
6. Exchange student

**ARTICLE III
PLAN OF OPERATION**

A detailed description of the scope of activities shall be defined in Plans of Operations (PoOs) on faculty level which constitute an integral part of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and is given in annex(es) which must also be signed by both parties.

The PoOs shall be drawn up and agreed by both parties, as agreed by the Ministry of National Education and approved by Government of Indonesia.



ARTICLE IV CONTRIBUTION BY THE (1)

In accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations, and subject to personnel and budget limitation the (1), shall:

- a) Provide laboratory facilities, accommodations, research transportations for visiting researchers, and research permission for visiting researchers.
- b) Provide necessary funding for the execution of the obligation to the (1) as specified in the PoOs.

ARTICLE V CONTRIBUTION BY THE (2)

The (2), subject to personnel and budget limitation, shall:

- a) Assign qualified experts and lecturers to assist in the implementation of activities under this MoU.
- b) Provide the necessary funding for the execution of the obligations of the (2) as specified in the PoO.
- c) Assist in arranging the necessary permits including work and study permits, for approved staff and students from the (1) to enter and leave the Netherlands.

ARTICLE VI JOINT RESEARCH

The (1) and the (2) can bring in research topics and materials, including the provision of samples. Transfer of samples to outside the country of origin must be accompanied by separate Material Transfer Agreement (MTA). All expenses for the research should be obtained from the (1) and the (2) or from external research grants.

ARTICLE VII PUBLICATIONS AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS OF RESULTS

The (1) and the (2) shall jointly have publication right of the data and research findings, the title of patent rights, copy rights if possible, and other intellectual property rights to any discoveries, inventions, and works resulting from this MoU, and each of whom shall have one-half pro indiviso share.

ARTICLE VIII SETTLEMENT OF DIFFERENCES

Any differing view point and interpretation of this MoU shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation.

**ARTICLE IX
AMENDMENTS, DURATION AND TERMINATION**

1. Amendment to this MoU can only be made after consultation and be written by mutual consent from both parties.
2. This MoU shall be effective from the date of its signing and be valid for the duration of 3 years from that date, and will be automatically renewed on an annual basis thereafter unless terminated or replaced with a new MoU.
3. This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party by written notice at least six months in advance. If so, the execution of existing activities will be continued.
4. This MoU replaces the MoU which was signed by both parties November 22, 2000.
