



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
DIPONEGORO UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA
AND
CATHOLIC KWANDONG UNIVERSITY, SOUTH KOREA**



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered by and between Diponegoro University, hereinafter referred to as Undip, having its registered business address at Jl. Prof. Soedarto, SH, Tembalang, Semarang, Central Java, Indonesia, telephone +62 24 7460012 Fax +62 24 7460013;
and

Catholic Kwandong University, hereinafter referred to as CKU having its registered address at 24, Beomil-ro 579 beon-gil, Gangneung-si, Gangwon-do, 210-701 South Korea. The parties shall be referred to jointly as Parties and individually as Party.

The Parties have common interest in promoting mutual co-operation in education, academic activities of the faculty and administrative staff, and jointly exploring research.

Therefore, pursuant to the prevailing laws and regulation in Indonesia and Korea, as well as the procedures and policy of the Government of the corresponding countries concerning International Technical Co-operation, Undip and CKU hereby agree as follows:

**ARTICLE I
OBJECTIVE**

Through this agreement both institutions seek to enrich their instructional programs and promote global awareness among their students. The Parties, after approval by their responsible authorities, agree to pursue this agreement for academic cooperation.

1. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate and to enhance the academic cooperation between the Parties.
2. The Parties shall promote direct academic contact between their students as well as academic teaching staffs and technical specialists.

**ARTICLE II
MODES OF COLLABORATION**

The Parties shall endeavor to promote collaboration in various areas through a broad range of strategies, which in the initial stages may include but not be limited to:

1. Academic exchanges of students, faculty, and technical specialists.

2. The design of collaborative research projects, including the development of formal proposals for funding of such research.
3. Collaborative student projects, when feasible.
4. Collaborative applications for outside funding, such as foundation or government grants.
5. The exchange of students and professors for professional internships in regional business enterprises.

ARTICLE III ACTIVITIES IN SUPPORT OF COLLABORATION

The Parties recognize the importance of certain ancillary activities in support of these areas of research and technical collaboration. Principal among them shall be:

1. The regular exchange of students, staff and relevant publications and information generated by each of the Exchanging Institutions.
2. Regular communication concerning technologies and curriculum that will enable and enhance the substantive areas of collaboration referred to within this document.
3. Joint research

ARTICLE IV CONDITIONS FOR COLLABORATION

All collaborative efforts are by mutual agreement and in no way shall one party obligate the other.

1. Nothing in this agreement shall create binding obligations on one party by the other. All activities must be mutually agreed upon prior to the activity.
2. All participation by faculty or students in any aspect of these activities shall be entirely voluntary.
3. In formal negotiations, the Exchanging Institutions shall be represented by the President of Catholic Kwandong University and the Rector of Diponegoro University or their designees.
4. Regularly employed personnel, while involved in activities under the Agreement, shall remain subject to the rules and regulations of their home institution in all matters of employment, benefits, and medical and life insurance.

ARTICLE V
TERM OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement shall become effective when the signatories representing both institutions have affixed their signatures, and shall be effective for a term of five years. The agreement is to be automatically renewed at the end of each five year term, provided that neither institution gives written notice of the termination of this agreement to the other institution.

This agreement may be revised with the mutual consent of both parties.
