



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
UNIVERSITAS DIPONEGORO
AND
UNIVERSITÉ DE POITIERS**

Universitas Diponegoro, hereinafter referred to as the (1), and Université de Poitiers hereinafter referred to as the (2);

Considering their common interest in promoting mutual co-operation in the educational, research and community service, subject areas of medical sciences and biology applied to health

Pursuant to the prevailing laws and regulation in Indonesia, as well as the procedures and policy of the Government of Indonesia concerning International Technical Co-operation.

Have agreed as follows :

**ARTICLE 1
OBJECTIVES**

The objective of this cooperation will be in the fields of research and/ or training held in common between the two universities

**ARTICLE II
SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES**

The scope of activities of the co-operation shall include but not be limited to:

1. Exchange of teaching experiences
2. Development of courses/workshops/seminars
3. Staff development/ joint research
4. Community service/ extension training
5. Exchange scientific information
6. Exchange student
7. Development of Master Degree Program for students
8. A system of joined thesis program so-called "co-tutelle"

**ARTICLE III
PLAN OF OPERATION**

A detailed description of the scope of the activities shall be defined in a Plan of Operation which constitutes an Integral part of this Memorandum of Understanding and is given in annex(es) which must also be signed by both parties.

The Plan of Operation shall be drawn up and agreed by both parties, agreed by the Ministry of national Education and approved by Government of Indonesia.

To facilitate the development of such plans, each institution shall nominate a senior member of its staff to coordinate activities arising under this agreement.

**ARTICLE IV
CONTRIBUTION BY THE (1)**

In accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations, and subject to personnel and limitation the (1), shall :

- a) Provide laboratory facilities, local transportation, accommodation in the field station, research vehicles for visiting researchers, research permission for visiting researchers.
- b) Provide necessary funding for the execution of the obligation to the (1) as specified in the Plan of Operation

**ARTICLE V
CONTRIBUTION BY THE (2)**

The (2), Subject to personnel and budget limitation, shall :

- a) Assign qualified experts and lecturers to assist in implementation of activities under this Memorandum of Understanding.
- b) Provide the necessary funding for the execution of the obligations of the (2) as specified in the Plan of Operation
- c) Assist in arranging the necessary permits including work and study permits, for approved staff and students from the (1) to enter and leave France.

**ARTICLE VI
JOINT RESEARCH**

The (1) and the (2) can provide samples/subject of research. Transfer of samples to out side the country must be accompanied by separate document of Material Transfer Agreement (MTA). All expenses for the research should be obtained from the (1) and the (2) or from research grant of any sources.
